BE SURE TO...

- Stroll around quaint, historic **Old Montreal** – Join the bestselling MTL Detours Explore Old Montreal walking tour!
- Visit **Mont-Royal Park** and the chalet/lookout at the top or the islands of **Jean-Drapeau Park** for beautiful views of the Montreal skyline and St-Lawrence River
- Visit our public **farmers markets**, notably Jean-Talon and Atwater Markets (7 days/week, 8/9am-5/6pm)
- Explore **St-Laurent Boulevard** - especially between Sherbrooke St and St-Viateur (keep your eyes open for the murals and street art!). You can walk from the Old Port all the way up to Little Italy.
- Have Saturday or Sunday **brunch** it's a real Montreal experience! (Pro-tip: show up before 10am to avoid lines)
- Visit the **Plateau Mont-Royal** and/or McGill Ghetto areas to see our typical Victorian-era architecture and outdoor wrought-iron staircases (Highlight = Saint-Louis Square!) (Take the MTL Detours Plateau/Mile End Tours!)
- Visit **Quartier des Spectacles** (Entertainment District) – there's a good chance a festival is going, especially during the summer months! You can also go ice skating in the winter on Esplanade Tranquille!
- **Taste:** a bagel, a poutine and a smoked meat sandwich (maybe not all at once)
- If you like **churches** - be sure to visit **Notre-Dame Basilica** (Get tickets to see AURA!), Saint-Joseph's Oratory, Mary Queen of the World Cathedral, Christ Church Cathedral, Saint-Patrick's Basilica, Notre-Dame-de-Bon Secours Chapel
- If you like **history** museums - check out Pointe-à-Callière Archaeology Museum, McCord Museum (great Indigenous Peoples permanent exhibition), Château Ramezay Museum, Maison Saint-Gabriel
- If you like **art** - visit the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts (MMFA), MAC Contemporary Art Museum. Check out all the art galleries on Sherbrooke St near the MMFA or on St-Paul Street in Old Montreal (We love S16 Gallery + Galerie Le Royer)
- Experience a **live jazz** show at Upstairs and Diese Onze. Also Le Balcon – cabaret/dinner/music venue in an old church
- Wander around **McGill University** campus and visit the Redpath Museum of natural history (voluntary contribution)
- **Shop** to your hearts content on Sainte-Catherine Street in downtown (also Mont-Royal Ave, Laurier Ave, St. Denis St.)
- Be adventurous and navigate our **underground city**/pedestrian network (RESO) and try our Metro (subway)
- Non-snow season: rent a BIXI bike and take a ride along the **Lachine Canal** (bonus: stop for lunch at Atwater Market and a drink at the Canal Lounge barge bar!)
- **Eat** at one of our gourmet food halls – Le Central, Timeout Market and Le Cathcart
- Head east and check out the **Olympic Park**, Botanical Gardens, Biodome, Insectarium and Planetarium
- Catch a **drag show** at Cabaret Mado in the Gay Village or a **burlesque** show at the Wiggle Room
- Savour a **local craft beer** at Dieu du Ciel, 4 Origins, Terrasse St-Ambroise, Brasseur de Montréal, Le Saint-Bock, HELM
- Practice your French 😊
